

Research group "Salud de la Mujer". Facultad de Medicina. Universidad de Cartagena. Colombia This research is part of the CAVIMEC (Calidad de Vida en la Menopausia y Etnias Colombianas) Project.

METHODS

Comparative study carried out in women from the Colombian Caribbean of different ethnic groups (Mestizo, indigenous and afrodescendant), aged between 40-59 years, in postmenopause, who expressed had sexual partner and regular sexual activity. They were assessed in their own communities with a general questionnaire and the brief Female Sexual Function Index of 6 questions (FSFI-6).

To lower score, higher sexual deterioration and SD is a score ≤19. Data analysis was performed using the EPI-INFO-7. A p<0.05 was considered significant.

CONCLUSION

There was not observed significant difference in the presence of SD between users and nonusers of hormonal therapy. Women who take hormones had significantly lower presence of pain or discomfort during intercourse.
